

To create an atmosphere conducive for learning, students of New Horizon School - Los Angeles are expected to dress according to the uniform policy. Students are required to be in uniform during the school day. Students who are not "in uniform" will be issued a uniform violation notice, which will specify the rule violated. The accumulation of uniform notices will result in curtailing of free dress privileges.

Regular Uniform Days

(Kindergarten and Elementary students only)

Forest green Polo shirt/dress

Navy blue pants or shorts/skirt below knee Navy blue or white socks/leggings/tights

Black shoes

Navy blue sweater (a sweater is optional, but must be solid navy blue if worn)



(All students)
School T-shirt
Navy blue sports pants
Athletic shoes
Navy blue sweater (optional)



Assigned Free Dress Days

Occasionally students will be allowed to have a free dress day. On those days, students are encouraged to wear clean clothes, appropriate to an Islamic school setting. Islamic dress, such as a white robe ("thoub") for boys and a cloak ("abaya") for girls, is an option, but not a requirement. Jeans and sleeveless tops are not allowed. Skirts should be below the knee.

Scarves

Girls must wear a white plain scarf daily for prayer and throughout the day, if they choose to wear one. On free dress days, any color scarf is allowed.

Uniform Sale

P.E. shirts (\$15), Polo shirts (\$20), and hooded full-zip sweatshirts (\$25) with school logo are available for purchase on campus. The school does not sell pants or skirts.
